The results in the more recent events are more important in the ranking than the older ones, therefore the years 2022 & 2023 count only half as much as (50% of the earned points) the years 2024 & 2025 (100% of the earned points). The final position in the ranking is reached by adding the points of all the 4 years accordingly and then dividing them by 4.

In case two federations have the same number of points, the points from the most recent year are compared to determine the final position in the ranking.
