

# OVERVIEW — EHF OFFICIALS COMPENSATION

## 1 General information

The costs (travel, match package etc.) for EHF Officials will be handled differently in the different EHF Club competitions. All financial matters are listed in this chapter.

In general, all costs related to the EHF Representatives will be handled by the EHF and afterwards charged to the respective club.

All remaining costs (eg board and lodging) have to be borne by the respective home club if not especially mentioned.

### 1.1 EHF Champions League Men

EHF handles all organisational matters. EHF M pays all financial costs related to EHF Officials.

### 1.2 EHF European League Men

#### 1.2.1 Qualification Round:

Clubs have to organise all travel arrangements and have to pay their appointed EHF officials directly prior to the match.

#### 1.2.2 Starting from the Group Matches:

EHF handles all organisational matters. Clubs have to pay all costs equally.

### 1.3 EHF European Cup Men

Clubs have to organise all travel arrangements and have to pay their appointed EHF Officials directly prior to the match. This is valid for all rounds.

### 1.4 EHF Champions League Women

EHF handles all organisational matters. Clubs have to pay equally all costs.

### 1.5 EHF European League Women

#### 1.5.1 Qualification round 1, 2 and 3:

Clubs have to organise all travel arrangements and have to pay their appointed EHF Officials directly prior to the match.

#### 1.5.2 Starting from the Group Phase:

EHF handles all organisational matters. Clubs have to pay all costs equally.

### 1.6 EHF European Cup Women

Clubs have to organise all travel arrangements and have to pay their appointed EHF Officials directly prior to the match. This is valid for all rounds.

## 2 Travel arrangements for EHF club competitions

The costs of EHF Officials appointed by the EHF shall be borne as follows:

### 2.1 Travel by train/bus/boat:

Reimbursement of the costs of one first-class ticket each for travel to and from the venue by train/bus/boat.

### 2.2 Air travel:

Reimbursement for the costs of one economy class ticket each.

### 2.3 Travel by car (allowed up to a max. distance of 600 km one way):

Reimbursement of the costs of one first-class ticket each for travel to and from the venue by train/bus/boat or economy ticket by plane.

- 2.3.1 Expenses for taxi during the trip: (E.g. home-airport-home, between airports, etc.): To be reimbursed against receipt
- 2.3.2 Car travel in the home town (e.g. home-airport-home, etc.):  
Reimbursement may be claimed at a rate of € 0,50 per kilometer
- 2.3.3 Any costs incurred outside or inside the host country in connection with the matches
- 2.3.4 All additional expenses during the trip (parking, visa, etc.) are to be reimbursed against receipt

## 3 Remuneration

There are only amounts for a complete match package. There are no additional daily allowances or match fees. The match package of the EHF Champions League Men and EHF European League Men is higher due to an additional weekday bonus (which is already included in the below-mentioned amounts)
